1.	VARDAR	KAVADARCI	Infrastructure and Energy efficiency improvement of Agricultural High School „Gjorche Petrov“ Kavadarci	Co-financing USD 5,455 Nordic support USD 82,017	Infrastructure and Energy Efficiency improvement of the Agricultural, Forestry, Educational High School „Gjorche Petrov“ Kavadarci. The project will improve the conditions for the education of 203 students and the working conditions for 60 employees of the school, while increasing the energy efficiency of the building and reducing the heating and cooling costs by 35%.
2.	NORTHEAST	KRIVA PALANKA	Creating the conditions for healthy generations	Co-financing USD 65,171 Nordic support USD 89,914	The project proposal encompasses construction of the energy efficient façade and carpentry works for the Municipal Public Kindergarten DETELINKA in Kriva Palanka. This project will improve the energy efficiency of the building, reducing the heating and cooling costs and will also reduce health hazards with the replacement of the asbestos roof. It will directly contribute to improved facilities for 380 children and 50 employees of the kindergarden and will also increase the capacity of the kindergarden to offer day long stay.
3.	SOUTHWEST	MAKEDONSKI BROD	Construction of fecal sewage with a treatment plant in the village Suvodol, Municipality of Makedonski Brod	Co-financing USD 43,210 Nordic support USD 90,000	The construction of a sewage system in the village of Suvodol will lead to an improved livelihood of 240 residents of the village. The sewage system will improve the communal infrastructure, reduce groundwater pollution and improve the living conditions for the residents. The project will directly contribute to an improved quality of life of locals, reduce environmental pollution and potential health hazards.
4.	POLOG	ZELINO	Reconstruction of primary school “Ibrahim Temo” Strimnica	Co-financing USD 39,980 Nordic support USD 90,000	The replacement of the windows, the reconstruction of the floors and the façade of the school in Zelino will improve conditions for the education of 258 students, and the working condition of 32 employees in the Primary School “Ibrahim Temo” Strimnica in Zelino. The project will improve the energy efficiency of the building, reducing the heating by 20% amounting to a minimum of 1,000 EUR savings per year.
